## Commercial Activity Continues at Canada-U.S. border

March 18, 2020

On March 18, 2020, the governments of the United States and Canada announced a full closure of the Canada-U.S. border to non-essential travel. The announcement effectively seals off Canada's border to all individuals who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada. It also seals the U.S. border from travellers arriving from a number of countries, including Canada, China, Iran and numerous European nations, including the United Kingdom and Ireland.

It is important to understand that these border and entry restrictions **<u>DO NOT</u>** apply to the movement and/or passage of commercial goods across borders. Trade will continue to take place between the U.S. and Canada on land, in the air and at sea.

We will continue to monitor events closely and remain committed to optimizing our service levels while ensuring the health and safety of our associates. We are equally committed to keeping you up to date about critical changes related to trade taking place in response to COVID-19.
